FREE YOUTH FEBRUARY RETURNS TO SENECA PARK ZOO

Up to five youth can visit the Zoo for free with every adult ticket purchased

For every adult who purchases an admissions ticket in February, up to five youth guests (ages 3-11) can join them on their Zoo visit for free. Children under 3 are always free of charge.

“Winter is one of the best seasons to visit the Seneca Park Zoo and Celebrate More outdoor activities throughout our Bicentennial year,” said Monroe County Executive Adam Bello. “I invite all Monroe County families to come out and learn more about animal activity in the cooler weather by taking advantage of Free Youth February. It’s a fun and affordable way to enjoy our beautiful zoo.”

Guests visiting the Zoo in February will see just how active many of the animals, like the polar bear, red panda, and snow leopard, are in the cooler months. Wintertime is a great opportunity to experience our Zoo.

Advance tickets are recommended and can be purchased online at <https://senecaparkzoo.org/tickets/>. Seneca Park Zoo is open from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. with last entry at 3 p.m. Adult admission (ages 12-62) is \$10 during the winter season. Free youth offer only valid on the same day of purchase.
