Seneca Park Zoo to celebrate International Red Panda Day on September 28

September 26, 2019 – Seneca Park Zoo is celebrating International Red Panda Day this **Saturday, September 28**. Guests will learn all about red pandas and why they are important through feeding demonstrations, keeper chats, crafts, interactive stations, and more. Guests will also learn about the threats red pandas face in nature and what they can do in their own lives to help protect this endangered species.

Now in its 10th year, International Red Panda Day is officially recognized on the third Saturday of September. The annual event is organized by the Red Panda Network, an organization committed to the conservation of red pandas and their habitat through the education and empowerment of local communities.

For a donation to the Red Panda Network, guests can enter multiple drawings to win prizes including a behind-the-scenes experience, a red panda painting, and a Monroe County Parks Family Fun Pack.
