Seneca Park Zoo to celebrate World Rhino Day on September 22

September 20, 2019 – Seneca Park Zoo is celebrating World Rhino Day this **Sunday, September 22** with a special rhino experience, a rhino keeper chat, and a banana eating contest between Zoo guests and the Zoo's resident white rhino, Bill.

Guests can visit a variety of interactive stations to learn about the importance of rhinos as megaherbivores, the threats rhinos face in nature due to human impact, and the organizations involved in rhino conservation. Guests will also learn about the simple actions they can take in their own lives to help protect this threatened species.
