2. Is a snow leopard an herbivore, omnivore, or carnivore?

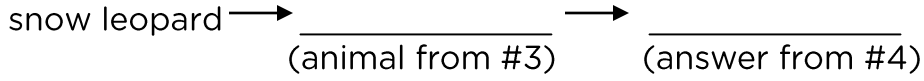
3. Seneca Park Zoo is home to an animal that could be prey for a snow leopard. What is that animal?
