August 8, 2019 – This **Saturday, August 10**, is World Lion Day and Seneca Park Zoo is celebrating with special animal experiences and activities. Guests will learn all about lions through a training session, enrichment demonstrations, biofacts, interactive stations, and more. Animal care staff will share what it's like to care for the Zoo's three African lions, Chester, Asha, and Zuri, while interactive stations will teach guests about the threats facing lion populations worldwide and the simple actions people can take to help protect them.
