

# CAMP THEME DESCRIPTIONS

## 3 & 4 years old

# CAMP THEME DESCRIPTIONS

## 10-12 years old

### **June 29-July 3: Adaptation Investigation**

Animals have lots of adaptations that help them survive in their habitats! Whether it's an armadillo's armor or a snow leopard's tail, animals have impressive features that make them unique! In this camp, we'll explore the coolest animal adaptations in the Zoo.

### **July 6-10: Animals in Art**

Animals are used in art around the world. In this camp, we will use them as inspiration for our own art projects!

### **July 13-17 Wild About Water**

Come get wild about water at the Zoo! We will play water games, learn about the water cycle, and discover how different animals use water in their habitats!

### **July 20-24: Zoo Careers**

There are a lot more people at the Zoo than just zookeepers. Learn about the many types of jobs someone at the Zoo might have in this fun camp!

### **July 27-31: Photo Safari**

Grab your camera and head to the Zoo! This week will focus not only on taking photos, but also learning fun techniques to take your photography to the next level!

### **Aug 3-7: Zoo Game Design**

Do you like board games or active games? In this camp, we will play all kinds of animal games, learn the basics of game design, and create our own zoo games to play using the animals as our inspiration.

### **Aug 10-14: ZooTeens in Training**

So, you want to be a ZooTeen? Learn the roles of a ZooTeen and help educate the public on the animals at the Zoo!

### **Aug 17-21: Wildlife Heroes**

Get to know superheroes in conservation and the animal world! These remarkable people have dedicated their lives to saving wildlife, and you can learn how. Be inspired by their stories and learn how you can help your own favorite animals.

## ADDITIONAL CAMP INFORMATION

Registrations are based on the age of the child as of June 1.

Campers will have a more positive experience if they are prepared to spend a part of each day outside and should dress accordingly. Snacks are provided, but please bring a water bottle.

Preschool camps for ages 3 and 4 are held weekly in June and run from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. with pick up before lunch. Campers will have a more positive experience if they are already comfortable in group settings without their parent and they must be bathroom trained. Two counselors support a maximum of 14 children. Half-day fees apply. Before or After Care options are not available.

School-age camps for ages 5 to 12 begin the week of June 29 and end the week of August 17. Camp runs 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily with Before Care drop off at 8 a.m. and After Care pickup at 5 p.m. Campers bring their own peanut-free lunch. Two counselors support a maximum of 20 children.

Special needs camp for ages 5 to 6 is held the week of July 6 and for ages 7 to 9 is held the week of August 10. Three counselors support a maximum of 14 children. This camp is tailored specifically for children with special needs that benefit from additional support. If your child is able to participate in camp but requires individual assistance with communication, behavior support, or ADLs, please contact us about arranging to have your own aide attend with your child, so they may have the most inclusive experience possible. Half-day option is available for these camps. Half-day is 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. with pick up before lunch.
